

## CÔTE DE NUITS-VILLAGES LE VAUCRAIN

### Vineyards situation

The Côte de Nuits is the northern of the two districts of the Côte d'Or ; stretching from Marsannay to Corgoloin. The AOC Côte de Nuits Villages extend on Brochon, Fixin, Prémieux Prisse, Comblanchien and Corgoloin.

### Characteristics

This 3.5 ha vineyard has been purchased by Maison Louis Jadot in 1996. Approximately 2.5 hectares are planted with Pinot Noir vines. The remaining part with Chardonnay. It is situated in the village of Comblanchien, and adjacent to the well known Clos de la Marechale, a famous Premier Cru of Nuits Saint Georges.

### Wine making

Our Côte de Nuits Villages "Le Vaucrain" white is vinified and then aged in oak barrels for 10 months before bottling.

### Winemaker's comments / Gastronomy

Côte de Nuits Villages « Le Vaucrain » from Maison Louis Jadot is a round and full wine, with aromas of white fruits flesh, which balance has been acquired during the ageing in casks.

This wine is perfect with white meat in creamy sauce and traditional cheeses.

### Preservation

Its fermentation in oak barrels will help this wine to easily age 5-7 years, depending on the vintages and conditions of temperature and humidity.
