Vineyards situation

Puligny-Montrachet is located south of Meursault and north of Chassagne-Montrachet. It is one of the most famous villages known for producing great white burgundies.

Characteristics

The premier cru « Hameau de Blagny » is located next to the small village of Blagny, between Champ Gain and La Garenne.

The soil is made of clay and limestone, very stony, well drained and easy to warm up. It is fully nicely east oriented.

Wine making

This wine is aged about 18 months in French oak barrels before being bottled.

Winemaker's comments / Gastronomy

Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru "Hameau de Blagny » is slightly lighter than his neighbours in Puligny, and it takes more time to reveal itself but it is fruitier and can age very well.

This great wine matches shellfish, fish and cheese such as old Comté and even Munster.

Preservation

This wine will be able to age very well, up to 15 years or more according to the vintages and to the conditions of storage.
