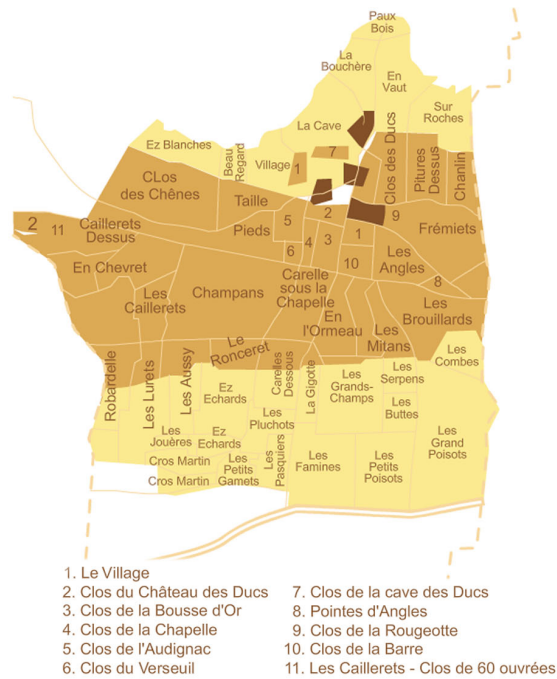


Côte de Beaune

## Vineyards situation

This Volnay is located on top of the Volnay hill above the Fremiets appellation.

## Characteristics

The soil of this Premier Cru is thin and made of cool marls and limestone enabling to produce fine and well-balanced wines.

## Wine making

Grapes are destemmed, fermented in vats and the wine is then aged in French oak barrels for 15 to 18 months before being bottled.

## Winemaker's comments / Gastronomy

Nice ruby red colour. The nose shows aromas of white raspberry and grey pepper with light hints of roasted coffee as well as discreet fresh fruits. The mouth is very fresh and the tannins are subtle.

## Preservation

It is a well-balanced wine with a good aging potential.
